
Terms around the "Trilateral Partnership in support of the UNESCO Wadden Sea World Heritage" (Version 06.04.2020)

Community

The "Trilateral Partnership in support of the UNESCO Wadden Sea World Heritage" is a strategic, multistakeholder, transboundary partnership, incorporating governmental and non-governmental sectors committed to the protection of the Wadden Sea and sustainable regional development. The partners concluded a memorandum of understanding to set goals and ambitions.



Working staff

The trilateral "Partnership Hub" supports management and organisation of the partnership as a networking unit. During the start-up-phase, the staff of the Partnership Hub is directly associated to the Common Wadden Sea Secretariat. The partners agreed on a first concept for setting up the hub.

Location

The "Trilateral Wadden Sea World Heritage Partnership Centre" is a building, currently under construction, which will serve Partnership Hub, Common Wadden Sea Secretariat and International Foundation as homebase and the trilateral partnership as a location for meetings, workshops and conferences. The building in Wilhelmshaven shall be finalised by the end of 2021.
